New for 2022: Rimfire Precision!

The newly created Rimfire Precision section hosts weekly CMP and NRL22 practice sessions for 22LR rifle shooters.

CMP started out as a branch of LEAP and has been running on Monday nights since May 2021. It's reasonably well-attended with a core group of about a dozen members. We've had many more come out to try and then attend on a sporadic basis. This program is open to members and non-members alike and has been the reason that several non-member attendees decided to join the club this year. In 2021 we had a total attendance of 178 shooters over 37 matches. CMP is a very simple course of fire. The focus is on the fundamentals of static positional (prone/kneeling/seated/standing) shooting.

NRL22 started in February of this year and has been running successfully every Thursday night. This group regularly competes in local (and some not-so-local) NRL22/RPS/CRPS matches. This program is also open to members and non-members alike. NRL22 courses of fire involve multiple targets at multiple distances per engagement. The shooter must learn to hold-over or dial their scope properly. These courses are often shot from barricades with transitions between different positions on the barricade. NRL22 is dynamic and the focus is on shooting from uncomfortable positions and moving between these positions safely and efficiently.

We hope to see you at one or both of these practices.
